MEXICAN GARDENS, 25 W. Columbia (961-2874) (off Woodward) NO Cucaraches in the Tortillas here. Watch the spices, Mucho Hot.

NEW YORK BAGEL BAKERY, 19140 Schaefer (DI8-1356) 7-cents bagels are still hot when you buy them. Cream cheese sold here.

THE SHEIK CAFE — 316 E. Lafayette (WO4-8441) Its Syrian Shish Kabob is the dish to dig.

THE CEDARS — 74 W. Columbia (WO3-7254) The only place for a long ways around that you'll hear live music & skilled belly dancers.

MILROY'S FISH & CHIPS — 12530 Kelly (LA1-9349) Their Fish & Chips to go are the best deal. The Scottish brogue flies around the place so thick you could slice it.
